

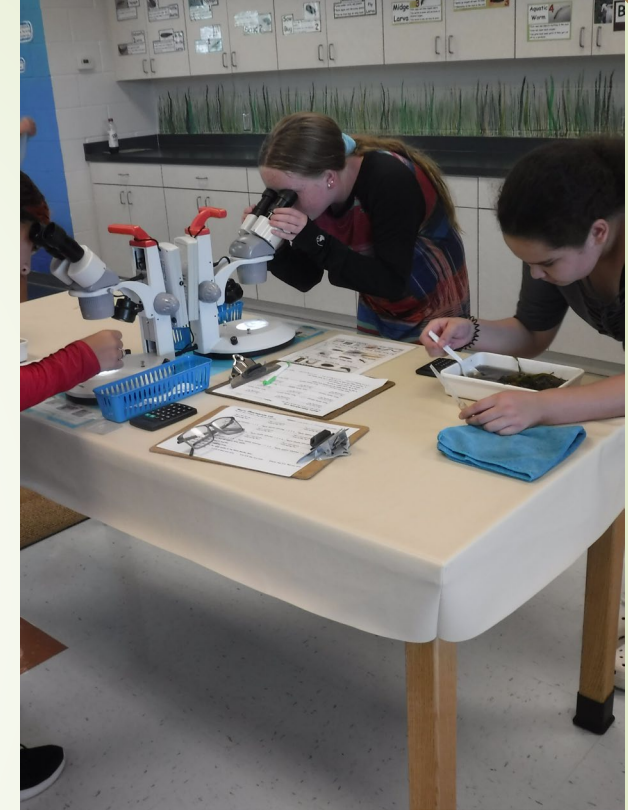

Sixth Grade Program

By the numbers:

1200 Sixth grade students experience a 4.5 hour field trip to kayak, complete a macroinvertebrate lab and take a nature walk. Pre test scores averaged 22%. Post test scores averaged 96%.



Fifth Grade Program



By the numbers:

1 600 fifth grade students experienced a 4.75 hour field trip to explore animal skulls, complete a saw palmetto survey, do a water cycle model demonstration and a digital scavenger hunt. Pre test scores averaged 15%. Post test scores averaged 95%.



Fourth Grade Program

SCEEC is the place to be!



By the numbers:

1 500 fourth grade students experienced a 4.5 hour field trip to learn about water conservation and the scrub habitat. Activities include a groundwater model, stick game, survivor game, water journey game, only a drop to drink activity, rain water collection site and a nature walk in the scrub habitat.



Second Grade Program



By the numbers:

1 600 Second grade students experience a 3.5 hour field trip to learn about box turtles and how to save or waste water. They make animal tracks out of plaster. They study mealworms, rock, and butterflies. Pre test scores averaged 11%. Post test scores averaged 94%.
